Columbus Commons Announces 2025 Season Schedule with New Events and Free Common Ground Concert

National artist Nelly joins the line-up of 200+ events at Columbus Commons this year

(Columbus, Ohio) – Columbus Commons will begin its 2025 season on April 17 with more than 200 events, many of which are free, including the 2025 Common Ground Concert featuring artist and 3x Grammy award-winning rapper Nelly on July 20, 2025.

In addition to regular food trucks, fitness classes, concerts, and family-friendly programming, new changes to the 2025 season schedule include Taco Tuesday featuring food trucks serving tacos, Latin dishes, and more on the first Tuesday of each month, and Howl-O-Ween, a free dog-centric event this October. Columbus Commons is also partnering with Friends of the Columbus Metropolitan Library to install and stock a Little Free Library at the south end of the park in the Bosque.

<u>Downtown Columbus, Inc.</u> and <u>Columbus Association for the Performing Arts (CAPA)</u> invite the central Ohio community to the 2025 Common Ground Concert featuring Nelly on Sunday, July 20, 2025. The show will be free to attend, but tickets will be required to enter Columbus Commons. Tickets will be released online on Wednesday June 25 at 10 a.m. Newsletter subscribers are eligible for the early ticket release on Tuesday, June 24. Subscribe to the newsletter here.

The fun kicks off on Thursday, April 17 marked by free daily carousel rides and the reopening of Jeni's Splendid Ice Creams and Tortilla Street Food.

Set within the scenic Downtown skyline, Columbus Commons is a six-acre park and gathering space for Central Ohio, a backyard for Downtown residents and an attraction for people of all ages. The space is managed and programmed by Downtown Columbus, Inc.
