CREATE CONNECTIVITY

The Capital Line will provide a new and safe way to walk or bike through Downtown Columbus, along with an easily accessible connection to transit.

CATALYZE DEVELOPMENT

The Capital Line will attract new investment, foster future developments along its path, spur new public art and support first floor retail, enabling economic growth.

A driver of economic development

The call for connectivity came from community input into the Downtown Columbus Strategic Plan, and inspiration for the concept can be seen in similar successful projects in other cities.

Notable examples include the **Cultural Trail in Indianapolis, which generated \$1 billion in economic inpact along the trail**, to the High Line in New York and the BeltLine in Atlanta. National precedents for this type of infrastucture investments also demonstrate a significant ROI for communities that create them - an average of \$27 return for every \$1 invested.







Phase I

Design is already underway for Phase I, which includes a complete reimagining of Gay Street (82 feet from property line to property line), along with the inaugural segment of the Capital Line. Progress to date includes:

- Submission of Stage 1 design to the City of Columbus
- Completion of an extensive survey of Phase I including
 16 basement vaults
- Began the process to hire a Construction Manager to start in Spring 2025
